ORDINANCE NO. 1250.

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$ 1,108³⁸
TO PAY ASSESSMENT LEVIED AGAINST THE PROPERTY OF THE CITY UNDER
ASSESSMENT No. 52, IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT No. 3, OF THE CITY OF
WARRENTON.

WHEREAS, there has been assessed against the City
of Warrenton in Improvement District No. 3, City Assessment No. 52,
pursuant to Ordinance No. 328, the sum of \$852.60, which the City
of Warrenton has not paid and upon which there is due interest
from (September 1, 1922), at the rate of 6% per annum, aggregating
at this date the sum of \$ (1,108³⁸) ; and

WHEREAS, bonds of the City have been issued and sold
for the purpose of paying for assessments levied by said assessment
and which have not been paid, including the amount due from the
City of Warrenton; and

WHEREAS, JOHN SLOTTE & CO. is the owner of all the bonds
issued, sold and delivered, pursuant to such improvement.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS
FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated out
of the *general* fund of the city the sum of \$852.60, plus
interest thereon at the rate of 6% per annum from (September 1, 1922)
to ^{Sept 1, 1927} ~~date~~, aggregating the sum of \$ (1,108³⁸) , to pay for the
assessment levied against the following described lands and
premises belonging to the city, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the west pierhead line of the Skipanon Waterway as now established by the Common Council of the City of Warrenton, said point being S 63° 03½' E and 1375.46 ft. distant from the northwest corner of Section 22, T. 8 N. R. 10 W. W.M.;
thence North 19° east along said pierhead line 785.50 ft. to the southeast corner of a 20 acre tract of land leased by the City of Warrenton to the Prouty Lumber and Box Company, which point is the point of beginning of the tract of land hereinafter described;
thence along said west pierhead line N 19° E 837.43 ft. to the northeast corner of said 20 acre tract of land;
thence N 65° 44½' W 1104.6 ft. to the west line of the parcel of land owned by the City of Warrenton;
thence S 19° W 837.43 ft. to the southwest corner of the parcel of land owned by the City of Warrenton;
thence S 65° 44½' W 1104.6 ft. to the point of beginning, containing 21.15 acres,

levied and assessed under and pursuant to City Assessment No. 52, and located in Improvement District No. 3.

Section 2. That said sum be paid to John Slotte & Co. and applied upon the bonds which this city has heretofore issued to secure the funds with which to pay such assessments, and when so paid, the same to be endorsed upon such bond or bonds, as the case may be. PROVIDED, ALWAYS, that such payment shall be made upon the condition that said John Slotte & Co. is the owner of all the bonds issued for such Improvement District, which fact shall be established to the satisfaction of the City Manager, and payment shall be made upon the certificate of such manager, filed with the Auditor and Police Judge.
