

ORD # 137

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE COMPILATION AND PRINTING  
OF A CITY CHARTER AND EMPOWERING AND DIRECTING THE AUDITOR  
AND POLICE JUDGE TO SEE THAT THE SAME IS DONE.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Auditor and Police Judge be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to forthwith compile and collate and properly index, in one volume, all the general laws, including the original charter as amended from time to time (omitting the parts thereof that are not now effective), and the general ordinances, of the City of Warrenton, and to have 200 complete and 200 galley forms ^ copies thereof printed and bound in such a manner and by such person or persons as he may deem for the best interests of the City of Warrenton.

Section 2. That the cost of compiling, collating, printing and binding the general laws of the City of Warrenton, as provided by Section 1 of this ordinance, shall be paid out of the general fund of such city upon warrants duly issued on such fund.
