

ORDINANCE NO. 166.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PREVENTION AND REMOVAL OF OBSTRUCTIONS TO THE STREETS AND SIDE-WALKS OF WARRENTON.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to leave upon the streets, alleys or side-walks of the City of Warrenton for a greater period than twenty-four hours any boxes, wood, coal, lumber or other building material, or any other obstruction to the use of any street, alley or side-walk, without first obtaining permission in writing from the Committee on Streets and Public Ways of the Common Council. It shall also be unlawful for any person to leave any wagon, cart, buggy, dray or other vehicle standing upon any improved street for a longer period than 10 hours, or leave any such wagon, cart, buggy, or dray when not being used, standing upon any street of the City of Warrenton in the night time.

Section 2. It shall be the duty of the owner of any boxes, wood, coal, lumber or other material, or any other obstruction to the use of any street, alley or side-walk, or the owner of any wagon, cart, heck, buggy, dray, or other vehicle, and likewise the occupant of any real estate adjacent to that part of the street or side-walk upon which there is any of the obstructions mentioned in Section 1 of this ordinance, to remove the same within twenty-four hours after being served with written notice so to do by the City marshal or other police officer; PROVIDED, that nothing contained in this section shall be construed so as to prevent punishment of any person for violating any section of this ordinance prior to the service of said notice to remove such obstruction.

Section 3. It shall be the duty of the owner and also of the occupant of any lot or premises to remove from that portion of the street or side-walk which is adjacent to said lot or premises all snow, ice and earth thereon within twenty-four hours after being given written notice so to do by the city marshal or police officer; provided that this section shall only apply to improved streets.

Section 4. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, in the police court of the

City of Warrenton, be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00 or more than \$100.00, or by imprisonment in the City Jail not less than two or more than fifty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
