

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE WATER SYSTEM IN ORDER TO SUPPLY WATER TO THE OWENS ADAIR RANCH, AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A FOUR INCH MAIN FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUCH EXTENSION

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the city water system of the City of Warrenton be extended by putting in a four inch main along the Oregon Coast Highway from a point commencing where the road leading out of the west end of the City of Warrenton intersects the Oregon Coast Highway to a point just opposite the west boundary line of the Owens Adair Farm, said four inch main to run along the Oregon Coast Highway in accordance with a permit already issued to the City of Warrenton by the Oregon State Highway commission.

Section 2. That the Mayor and City Manager be and he is hereby authorized and empowered under and pursuant to this ordinance to call for bids for the purpose of making such improvement, said call for bids to be under such terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Mayor and City Manager, said improvement not to exceed the sum of \$3,000⁰⁰

Section 3. The Mayor and City Manager shall be authorized to let the contract for the extension of said water system upon his first obtaining from J. O. Convill an agreement on the part of J. O. Convill to purchase water from the City of Warrenton for a period of fifteen years at the rate of Two Hundred (\$200) dollars per year, and under such other conditions as may be prescribed by the City of Warrenton other than within this ordinance provided, and unless such agreement is made this ordinance shall be null and void; otherwise in full force and effect.
