

ORDINANCE NO. 158

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING HORSES AND MULES OF ALL SEXES AND AGES FROM RUNNING ~~IN PLEACE~~ ^{outside of enclosures} WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS AND PROHIBITING COLTS OF ALL SEXES AND AGES WEARING BELLS FROM RUNNING ~~IN PLEACE~~ ^{outside of enclosures} WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That all horses and mules, of all sexes and ages, including colts, are hereby prohibited from running ~~at large~~ ^{outside of enclosures} within the city limits of the City of Warrenton.

Section 2. That all cows, of all ages and sexes, including calves, which wear or have attached to any part of their bodies, bell or bells or any other instrument or device which makes any noise whatsoever, are hereby prohibited from running ~~at large~~ ^{outside of enclosures} within the city limits of the City of Warrenton.

Section 3. That any ^{person} violating ~~is~~ any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$1.00, nor more than \$100.00, or by imprisonment in the city jail for a period not to exceed twenty-five days, or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Auditor and Police Judge.

Section 4. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
