ORDINANCE NO. 173.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF REVENUE REQUIRED FOR MUNICIPAL EXPENSES DURING FISCAL YEAR 1917-1918 BY LEVYING A TAX UPON ALL THE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF WARRENTON, INCLUDING TAX FOR THE VARIOUS DYKE DISTRICTS THRUOUT THE CITY.

WHEREAS, it appears to the satisfaction of the Common Council that. at a meeting of the taxpayers of the City of Warrenton, duly called and held on the 17th day of November, 1916, in the City Hall of said City, at which meeting there were assembled more than a majority of the legal voters of said City, the budget hereinafter set out in detail was adopted by a unanimous vote of all of the taxpayers at said meeting; now, therefore:

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be, and there hereby is, made and created upon all the property, of all kinds and description, which is taxable. within the City of Warrenton, the following enumerated tax levies, towit:

Five (5) mills for the purpose of creating revenue to pay the general expenses of operating and conducting the usual business of the city. which is ordinarily known and designated as the "general fund".

Three (3) mills for the purpose of creating revenue to pay the interest on the outstanding issue of water bonds, and also to pay the general expense of maintenance and up-keep of the city water system, should the income from sales of water be insufficient to pay same. Three and one-half (32) mills for the purpose of creating a fund

to wil to pay for opening and improving the following described streets, Wheeler Street from Albany Avenue to Parific Street & Madison Avenue from County Read to Where of Warney on And the following tax levies are hereby made upon the property in the respective dyke districts enumerated as follows: Four (4) mills for the purpose of creating a "dyke fund" for Dyke chan (00. proprinty

District No.1 in said City, upon all the property in such Dyke District No.1.

Four (4) mills for the purpose of creating a "dyke fund" for Dyke District No.2 in said City, upon all the property in such Dyke District No.2.

Two (2) mills for the purpose of creating a "dyke fund" for Dyke District No.3 in said City, upon all the property in such Dyke District No.3.

Section 2. That the passage of this ordinance and the taking ef-fect of same immediately is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Warrenton, as the law provides that the aforesaid tax levy shall be made and placed in the hands of the Assessor of Clatsop County, Oregon, prior to December 1, 1916, and this ordinance pertains to municipal business of a purely local nature, as contradistinguished from municipal legis-lation; now, therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
