

An ordinance granting unto the Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company permission to erect poles for the purpose of hanging wires thereon, on Madison Avenue, from

The Easterly line of Walnut street
to the east end of Madison
avenue as shown on said deed ^{of said Avenue} in the City of Warrenton, Oregon;

Providing for supervision in erecting said poles, and termination of this permit upon notice.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

Section 1. That the Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, be and the same is herewith granted permission to erect poles for the purpose of hanging wires thereon, on Madison Avenue, from

the Easterly
line of Walnut street to the east end of Madison ave as shown
in the City of Warrenton Oregon.

Section 2. Poles shall be erected on said Madison Avenue, between said points, where practicable, and poles shall be so erected so as to interfere as little as possible with traffic over said Avenue.

The location of all poles shall be fixed under the supervision of the street and Public Improvement Committee of the Common Council of the City of Warrenton, or the successors to the duties of said Committee, but not so as to interfere with the proper operation and use of said poles and wires hanging thereon.

Section 3. This permit may be terminated upon ninety (90) days notice being given to the Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company by the Common Council of the City of Warrenton, Oregon.
