

An ordinance providing for the time and manner of improving ^{in Flavel Addition to Warrenton} First street from its intersection with Multnomah Avenue and Vermont streets, and running thence west a distance of 170 feet;.

WHEREAS, due and legal notice of the intention and determination of the Common Council of the City of Warrenton to improve First street from its intersection with Multnomah Avenue and Vermont streets, and running thence west a distance of 170 feet, has been given by publication for 10 days in the Warrenton News, as appears from the proof of publication on file with the Auditor and Police, ^{Judge} and the City Surveyor has made and filed estimates of the costs and expenses of constructing said improvement and specifications for the proposed work, and no remonstrance has been filed against said improvement.

THEREFORE THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

Section One. That First street from its intersection with Multnomah Avenue and Vermont streets, and running thence west a distance of 170 feet be and the same is herewith ordered improved, by planking said street with two ^{eight feet in length} by 12 planks, laid upon two by twelve stringers, said planks to be red or yellow fir lumber, all in accordance with resolution adopted on the 14th day of February 1917; proof of publication of intention to improve said street, and plans and specifications filed by the City Surveyor, which said resolution, proof of publication and plans and specifications are hereby referred to and made a part hereof as though set out in full herein.

Section two. That the committee on streets and public improvements be and the same is herewith directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement and ^{to} report the same to the Council, and upon the acceptance of lowest bid by the Council to enter into contract with such bidder for the construction of the improvement. The contract shall provide that said improvement shall be constructed ~~according to~~ and completed ~~satisfactorily~~ to the satisfaction of the committee on streets and Public improvement ~~committee~~ and city Surveyor and Supt. of streets, and that said improvement shall be

completed on or before the 12th day of May 1917,
unless the time be extended by ordinance, and for each day delay
in the completion of said improvement, unless extended the contractor
shall forfeit and pay to the city of Warrenton as stipulated
damages the sum of \$ 250/100.

That said improvement shall be made strictly as provided by the
plans and specifications and this ordinance and that the contractor
shall have full charge of the work and shall be responsible for
for all accidents and injuries occurring upon the street during the
progress of the work and save the City harmless from all damages
on account of an injury to any person or persons happening upon
the said portion of said street while in the course of construction.

The contract shall provide;
That the said party of the first part shall promptly, as due, make
payment to all persons supplying ~~labor~~ to the said contractor ~~labor~~
labor or material for the prosecution and completion of said
improvement and that he will not permit any lien or claim to be filed
or prosecuted against the city of Warrenton, for or on account of any
labor or material furnished him in the ~~pro~~ construction of said
improvement.

That during the performance of the work in the construction of
said improvement no person shall be required or permitted to ~~labor~~
labor more than eight hours on any callender day, or forty-eight hours
in any one callender weeck, except in cases of necessity, emergency
or where public policy absolutely requires it, and in such event
the person or persons so employed for excessive hours shall receive
double pay for the overtime so employed; and no emergency,
necessity, or public policy shall be presumed to exist when other
labor of like skill and efficiency which has not been employed full
time is available, and no person shall be employed by the said party
of the first part in the performance of this contract, who is not
a citizen of the United States of America, or who has not declared
his intention to become such.

That payments shall be made in warrants of the City of Warrenton
~~, either~~ upon a special fund constituted to defray the costs and
expenses of the improvement, and that payment shall be made within
ninety days from the time the improvement shall be accepted,
The contractor shall be required to give bond with two or more
sureties in the penal sum of \$ 20000 conditioned for
the faithful performance of the contract.
