

ORDINANCE NUMBER 179^A
INTRODUCED BY COMMISSIONER Geo. P. Sizer

An Ordinance providing for costs and disbursements to be assessed by the Auditor and Police Judge in all cases coming before him for violation of City ordinances and providing for the authority of the Auditor and Police Judge to remit such costs and disbursements in such cases as he shall deem advisable, and repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

The City of Warrenton does ordain as follows:

Section I

That in all cases for the violation of City ordinances filed in the Municipal Court in the City of Warrenton, where the defendant has plead guilty or has been found guilty upon trial, the Auditor and Police Judge shall assess against said defendant the sum of \$4.50 costs, which shall be paid by the defendant to the Auditor and Police Judge, and shall be turned over by him to the General Fund of the City of Warrenton.

Section II

The Auditor and Police Judge is hereby authorized and empowered to remit the payment of said costs in such cases as he may deem advisable, and a notation whether said costs have been assessed, levied and paid or remitted shall be made in the records of the Court in the same manner as fines are recorded.

Section III

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.
