

INTRODUCED BY COMMISSIONER Geo. P. Hizer

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON THE EMPTYING OF ANY SEWAGE IN ANY OF THE WATERS OF ANY STREAM, SLOUGH OR BODIES OF WATERS CONTROLLED BY A TIDE BOX OR TIDE BOXES, UNLESS SAID SEWAGE IS FIRST EMPTIED INTO A SEPTIC TANK OF STANDARD CONSTRUCTION AND OF SUFFICIENT CAPACITY TO PROPERLY PURIFY THE WATER RUNNING FROM SAID SEWAGE INTO ANY OF SUCH WATERS: PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE: AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES, OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

N O W T H E R E F O R E

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to permit within the City limits of the City of Warrenton, any sewage to be discharged or emptied into any of the waters of any stream, slough or bodies of waters controlled by a tide box or tide boxes, without first running said sewage through a septic tank, which is of standard construction and of sufficient capacity so as to assure the purification of said sewage before the same empties into any of said waters.

Section II. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof by the Police Judge shall be fined in a sum of not more than \$300.00 or by imprisonment in the City jail not to exceed 100 days, or both.

Section III. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.
