

ORDINANCE NO. 191

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE IMPROVEMENT OF MADISON AVENUE FROM THE EAST LINE OF THE RIGHT OF WAY OF THE SPOKANE, PORTLAND & SEATTLE RAILWAY COMPANY TO THE WEST LINE OF THE PROPERTY OF THE WARRENTON CLAY COMPANY, IN THE CITY OF WARRENTON, OREGON.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the improvement of Madison Avenue from the East line of the right of way of the Spokane, Portland & Seattle Railway Company to the West line of the property of the Warrenton Clay Company, in the City of Warrenton, Oregon, as improved by

of the City of Warrenton, and as accepted by the Committee on Streets and Highways of the City of Warrenton, be and the same is herewith accepted.
