

ORDINANCE NO. 192

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING OUT OF THE SPECIAL FUND, CONSTITUTED FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPROVING CERTAIN STREETS IN THE CITY OF WARRENTON, THE SUM OF \$ 1730<sup>00</sup>, FOR THE BENEFIT OF West Coast Construction Co FOR IMPROVING MADISON AVENUE FROM THE EAST LINE OF THE RIGHT OF WAY OF THE SPOKANE, PORTLAND & SEATTLE RAILWAY COMPANY TO THE WEST LINE OF THE PROPERTY OF THE WARRENTON CLAY COMPANY, IN THE CITY OF WARRENTON, OREGON.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is herewith appropriated out of the Special Fund constituted for the purpose of improving certain streets in the City of Warrenton, Oregon, the sum of \$ 1730<sup>00</sup> in favor of West Coast Construction Co contractors, payment in full for improving Madison Avenue from the East line of the right of way of the Spokane, Portland & Seattle Railway Company to the West line of the property of the Warrenton Clay Company, in the City of Warrenton, Oregon.

Section 2. That upon the passage and approval of this Ordinance, the Auditor and Police Judge of the City of Warrenton shall draw a warrant or warrants upon the said fund in favor of said West Coast Construction Co contractors, in said amount for improving said street.
