

ORDINANCE NO. 193

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE PLAT OF FAIRHAVEN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF WARRENTON AS FOUND IN THE BOOK OF PLATS OF CLATSOP COUNTY, OREGON, AND ALL STREETS INCLUDED THEREIN.

WHEREAS heretofore, on the 7th day of May, 1917, The Warrenton-Investment Company, a corporation, and the Western Oregon Corporation, a corporation, filed with the Auditor of the City of Warrenton their petition for the vacation of Fairhaven Addition to the City of Warrenton, and

WHEREAS your petitioners have fully set forth the reasons of said vacation of said Addition and a distinct description of such persons and corporations affected thereby and the Council being fully advised in the premises,

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS;

That all of that certain property known as Fairhaven Addition to the City of Warrenton, Clatsop County, Oregon, as laid out in a certain plat on file with the County Clerk of Clatsop County, Oregon, and being more particularly described as follows; The west one-half of the Northeast One-fourth and the Northwest One-fourth of the Southeast One-fourth of Section Seventeen (17) T. Eight (8) N. R. Ten (10) West W. M. together with all the Streets included in the bounds of said plat, as shown by a copy of said plat hereto attached, be and the same is hereby vacated and all Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
