ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING OUT OF THE GENERAL FUND OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING FOR A BRIDGE ON PORTLAND AVENUE BETWEEN YOULL STREET AND CONTUME STREET, ERECTED BY THE AMERICAN SHIPBUILDING COMPANY, A CORPORATION, THE SUM OF MONEY TO BE APPROPRIATED BEING \$ 143000

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is herewith appropriated out of the General Fund of the City of Warrenton, for the improvement of a bridge on Portland Avenue between <u>Garfield</u> Street and <u>Attuin</u> Street, in Warrenton, Oregon, the sum of \$ <u>173</u> in favor of the American Shipbuilding Company, a corporation, it appearing that said bridge or improvement is of vital importance to the general public of the City of Warrenton.

Section 2. That upon the passage and approval of this Ordinance, the Auditor and Police Judge of the City of Warrenton shall draw a warrant or warrants upon the said fund in favor of the said American Shipbuilding Company, a corporation, in said amount, for said bridge, and upon the payment of same, the said bridge and property to become the sole property of the City of Warrenton.
