

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF MORTON STREET AND A PORTION OF PORTLAND AVENUE, OF EAST WARRENTON, AND THE FIRST EXTENSION OF EAST WARRENTON, IN THE CITY OF WARRENTON, OREGON.

WHEREAS, a petition, for the vacating of a part of Morton Street, and a part of Portland Avenue, as hereinafter particularly described, was on the 28th day of August, 1917, duly filed with the Auditor and Police Judge of the City of Warrenton, Oregon; that said petition was signed by all the owners of the property, abutting upon the portions of said streets sought to be vacated; that said petition contains a particular description of the parts of said streets sought to be vacated, and the same appears to be in due form; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the filing of said petition with said Auditor and Police Judge, to-wit, on the 29th day of August, 1917, said Auditor and Police Judge posted notices in three of the most public places of said city, which notices remained so posted for a period of thirty successive days following said date of posting; that said notices contained a particular description of said streets sought to be vacated, and stated that said petition would be heard by the Common Council of the City of Warrenton, at this time; and

WHEREAS, it further appearing to the Council that the consent, in writing, duly executed, as provided by law, of all the owners of land abutting upon said parts of said streets sought to be vacated, has been duly filed with the County Clerk of Clatsop County, Oregon; and

WHEREAS, said petition came on regularly for hearing at this time, and no objections being made or filed to the vacation of the parts of said streets in accordance with the prayer of said petition, and no opposition being made to such vacation; therefore,

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That said parts of said streets be, and the same here-by are, vacated in accordance with the prayer of said petition; that is to say, the part of Morton Street, of East Warrenton, and the First Extension of East Warrenton, in the City of Warrenton, Oregon, described as follows:

All that portion of said Morton Street which lies North of a line drawn diagonally across such street, parallel with the Northerly boundary line of Hill's Slough, and 10 feet North thereof, the same being the North boundary of that portion of said Morton Street, which was vacated by said Council, on January 4, 1904, is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That the part of Portland Avenue, of East Warrenton, and the First Extension of East Warrenton, in the City of Warrenton, Oregon, described as follows:

All that portion of said Portland Avenue which lies West of the East boundary line of said Morton Street, is hereby vacated.

Enacted by the Common Council this 1st day of October, 1917.
