

An Ordinance confirming Special Assessment Roll No. 73.

WHEREAS, Special Assessment Roll No. 73 has been made by the Board of Assessors and reported to the Council and after due and legal notice equalized and corrected by the Board of Equalization duly reported to the Council with the recommendation that the same be confirmed, and it appearing that the same was regularly made as provided by law and that all property is justly assessed, therefore

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Special Assessment Roll No. 73, made for defraying the costs and expenses of improving Spruce Street in Warrenton Addition to Astoria in Warrenton, by laying a standard six foot sidewalk along the East side thereof, for a distance of 268 feet, more or less, running South from Second Street, and that said costs and expenses amount to \$153.55 upon the following described property, to-wit

be and the same is hereby confirmed and approved and the same is made payable <sup>or before</sup> on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of January 1918 and the Auditor and Police Judge is hereby directed to cause notice that said assessment is due, to be given by publication in the Warrenton News, a newspaper published and of general circulation in the City of Warrenton, Clatsop County, State of Oregon, for the time and in the manner as provided by the Charter of the City of Warrenton. *and said Auditor & Police Judge is hereby authorized to spread this assessment on the pocket of City dues and to proceed to collect the same as by law and the Charter provided.*
