

INTRODUCED BY COMMISSIONER Geo. W. Kelly.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF EQUIPMENT, SUPPLIES, MATERIAL AND MONEY FOR DEFENSE PURPOSES FROM THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY;

WHEREAS, The Federal Government may give, grant, loan, lease, or otherwise make available to the City of Warrenton for National Defense purposes, certain equipment, supplies, material, or money necessary to the proper functioning of defense activities in this city,

N O W T H E R E F O R E ,

T H E C I T Y O F W A R R E N T O N D O E S O R D A I N A S F O L L O W S :

Section I. The Mayor of the City of Warrenton is authorized to accept on behalf of this city all equipment, supplies, and materials and money offered by the Federal Government to enable this city to carry out any program, act or activity necessary to the proper functioning of defense activities in this city. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute such agreements or documents and to agree to such reasonable terms and conditions as may be required by the Federal Government for the grant, loan, lease or other use or possession of said equipment, supplies, materials or money.

Section II. In as much as the objects to be obtained by this ordinance will be of a great benefit to the City of Warrenton and its residents and inhabitants and in as much as there now exists a National Emergency which makes it imperative that this ordinance should become effective forthwith in order that the public safety, health, and welfare be provided for by prompt arrangements for the acceptance of the equipment, supplies, material or money referred to in this ordinance, an


emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this section shall take effect when approved by the affirmative vote of four members of the Commission of the City of Warrenton, and this ordinance shall then be in full force and operative immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
