ORDINANCE NO. 216.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 6 OF AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE WATER WORKS OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON, OREGON, ESTABLISHING RULES, REGULATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR USE OF WATER, ESTABLISHING RATES TO BE PAID FOR WATER SUPPLIED FROM SAID WATER WORKS, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE", SUCH AMENDED ORDINANCE BEING NO. 166, AND WAS ENACTED AND APPROVED ON THE 12th DAY OF JUNE, 1916.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That Section 6 of Ordinance No.166, entitled: "An ordinance regulating the water works of the City of Warrenton, Oregon, establishing rules, regulations and requirements for the use of water, establishing rates to be paid for water supplied from said water works, and providing penalties for the violation of this ordinance", be, and the same hereby is amended, to read as follows:

"Section 6. Separate charges for water shall be made, at regmular family rates, in the following cases:

(a) For every man and wife, with or without children, who live together in the same house or other place of habitation, other than regular hotels or rooming houses, the latter being specially classified elsewhere in this ordinance.

other than those mentioned in sub-section (a) above, (b) For one or more persons, who occupy one room or a suite of rooms together, whether their place of abode be in a private residence, or other building or place of habitation, other than in a regular hotel or rooming house, which are specially classified elsewhere in this ordinance."

Enacted by the Common Council, and approved by the Mayor, on this $4\frac{th}{t}$ day of February, A. D. 1918.
