ORDINANCE NO. 2-9-9

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF JUDGES AND CLERKS AND THE HOLDING OF NOTICE THEREOF FOR THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE 3RD DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1942; FOR THE ELECTION OF THREE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON, CLATSOP COUNTY, STATE OF OREGON.

WHEREAS, a general election as provided by the Charter of the City of Warrenton shall be held on the 3rd day of November, 1942, for the election of three commissioners, and that the entire City of Warrenton shall constitute one election precinct with the polling place at the City Hall of the City of Warrenton, said poll is to be open from eight o'clock in the morning until eight o'clock in the evening, without closing, as by the Charter provided; now, therefore,

**THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**


Section 1. That Oliver H. Wilson,  
Clementine E. Kelson, and Margaret E. Wallingford be, and they  
are hereby appointed Judges, and Edith Kelly  
Annie Smith be, and they are hereby appointed  
Clerks of the general election to be held in the City of Warren-  
ton on the 3rd day of November, 1942, and they are hereby order-  
ed and directed to be present at the polling place which is here-  
by declared to be the City Hall of said City of Warrenton, and  
attend to the casting of ballots in said general election as by  
law provided.

Section 2. That the Auditor and Police Judge is hereby ordered and directed to post notices of said election in three public places in the City of Warrenton, Oregon, which said notices shall notify the electors of the City of Warrenton of such general election, the officers to be elected, the place of holding of said election, and the names of the Judges and Clerks of said election, which said notices shall be so posted by said

Auditor and Police Judge more than ten days prior to the date set for such general election.
