## ORDINANCE NUMBER 230

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AN ORDINANCE retifying and confirming certain essements or rights of way granted to the Water Commission of the City of Warrenton, a Municipal corporation, by the CROWN WILLAMETTE PAPER COMPANY, a corporation, under, upon, over and across certain lands and premises in said essements described, situated lying and being in Section 19, Township 6, North of Range 9, West of Willamette Meridian, County of Clatsop, State of Oregon, Audducharing an introping

Thet WHEREAS, the CROWN WILLAMETTE PAPER COMPANY, e corporation, in consideration of one (\$1.00) dollar, has offered to grant unto the City of Warrenton and its Water Commission, an essement or right of way for the purpose of conveying and furnishing water to the City of Warrenton and its inhabitants, and to such other persons fegal or natural, as the City may desire to lay, construct, use, operate, maintain and repair a line of water pipe under, upon, over and across the following described premises in Clatsop County, State of Oregon, to-wit:

> The northeast quarter (1) and the north onehalf (N.1) of the southeast quarter (S.E.1) of Section mineteen (19) in Township Six (6), North of Range Nine (9), West of the Willemette Meridian, the center line of said pipe line through said premises being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the west line of the southeast quarter (S.E.<sup>1</sup>) of Section Mineteen (19) Township Six (6), North of Range Mine (9) West of the Willsmette Meridian, 3810 feet south of the quarter section corner between northeast and northwest quarters of said section nineteen (19), st a point six (6) feet east of the center line of the Old Railroad Grade, commonly known, and hereinafter designated as the Old Reid Grade, at Station 408-30; thence with a radius to the left of 948.4 feet, the tangent of said radius at the place of beginning beers south 86 22; East, 247.5 feet to a point six (6) feet north of Station 410.78.3; thence North 81 35; east 122 feet to a point in the center line of the Old Reid Grade at Station 413;30; thence North 75 56; East 70.2 feet to a point six (6) feet morth of Station 414.400; thence North 78 50; East 100 feet to a point six (6) feet North 61 Station 414.400; thence North 78 50; East 100 feet North 79 02; East 300 feet to a point five (5) feet North of Station 418.400; thence North 78 50; East 200.2 feet to a point in the center line of the Old Reid Grade at Station 413.430; thence North 75 56; East 70.2 feet to a point siz (6) feet North of Station 414.400; thence North 78 50; East 100 feet to a point six (6) feet North 61 Station 415.400; thence North 79 02; East 300 feet to a point five (5) feet North of Station 418.400; thence North 80° 15; East 200.2 feet to a point in the center line of the Old Reid Grade at Station 420; thence following the Center line of the Old Reid Grade, North 78° 50; East 19.28 feet to Station 420,19.28; thence continuing with the center line with a radius to the left of 573.7 feet, 466.67 feet to Station 424485.95; thence North 55° 18' East 14 feet to a point six (6) feet South of Station 425400; Thence North 28° 40' East 100.2 feet to a point in the center line of the Old Reid Grade at Station 426; thence North 32° 10' East 100.1 feet to a point one (1) foot north of station 427; thence north 40° 00' East 200 feet to a point fourteen (14) feet north of Station 429400; thence north 54° 00' East 100 feet to a point sixteen (16) feet north of Station 430; thence north 56° 42' East 200 feet to a point sixteen (16) feet north of Station 432; thence north 40° 12' East 208.3 feet to a point 75 feet north of Station 434; thence north 47° 12' East 152.6 feet to a point 100 feet north of Station 435-50; thence north 66° 12' East 152.6 feet to a point 75 feet north of Station 437; thence north 77° 16' East 253.6 feet crossing said center line at Station 439400 to a point on the East line of said Section 1810 feet south of the northeast (n.e.) corner thereof.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

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Section 1. That the City of Warrenton does hereby accept the essement right of way heretofore contracted for by the City of Warrenton and M. J. Kinney, the said premises having since been conveyed to the said CROWN WILLAMETTE PAPER COMPANY in accordence with contract entered into with the said M. J. Kinney for said essement and right of way for pipe line purposes, and the Mayor of the City of Warrenton is hereby authorized and empowered to execute an essement agreement with the said CROWN WILLAMETTE PAPER COMPANY covering the aforesaid essement and right of way, and the Auditor and Police Judge shall attest the same with his signature and the seal of the City of Warrenton.

Section 2. Insemuch as the objects to be obtained by this Ordinance will be of great benefit to the people of the City of Warrenton, and there exists and is an urgent necessity that this Ordinance should take effect as soon as possible, so that the peace and safety of the people of the City of Warrenton may be preserved, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Section therefore, shall take effect when adopted by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members of the Common Council, and this Ordinance shall then be in full force and effect immediately after its approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton. Passed the Common Council this <u>374</u> day of <u>September</u> 1918.
