2 AN ORDINANCE, regulating the plumbing and drainage of build-
3 ings in the City of Warrenton, providing a penalty for violation
4 thereof and declaring an emergency,

5 THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

6 Section 1. No plumbing work of any description, either in
7 the tapping the water main or making connections with any lateral
8 or pipe line extending from the water main running into any build-
9 ing or buildings, ^{or in any building or buildings,} / or at any point between said water main and said
10 building or buildings, / shall be done in the City of Warrenton by
11 any person, persons, firm or corporation without a permit being
12 first issued by the ~~Auditor and Police Judge~~ ^{Clerk of the Water Commission} of the City of War-
13 renton therefor, upon such terms and conditions as the Water Com-
14 mission of the City of Warrenton shall prescribe, and when such
15 plumbing work involves or necessitates the obstruction of a Street
16 or alley, tearing up sidewalks or disturbing the surface of streets
17 or alleys, a permit shall also be obtained from the said ~~auditor~~ ^{Clerk of the}
18 ~~and Police Judge~~ ^{Water Commission} for such purposes.

19 Section 2. Any contractor or plumber who is employed to per-
20 form any work on any house, building, premises or any place re-
21 quiring plumbing, shall obtain a permit as in Section 1 provided,
22 and said permit shall further provide that ~~all~~ ^{any} person, persons,
23 firm or corporation performing plumbing work in or about said
24 building, buildings, premises, streets, alleys or otherwise, shall
25 save harmless the City of Warrenton from all suits, accidents, and
26 damages consequent thereupon, for or by reason of any opening on
27 any street, alley or avenue made by such person, persons, firm or
28 corporation, or by those in the employ of such person, persons,
29 firm or corporation, with any public or private connection with the
30 City water main or any water pipe leading from said water main,
31 into any building or buildings, or for any other purpose or object
32 whatever, and that he will also repair and restore the street over
33 such opening to as good a state and condition as he found it, keep-
34 ing guards by day and light by night ^{during the period of construction} ~~and keep and maintain the same~~
~~in good order~~ to the satisfaction of the Committee on Streets and
Public Ways, and subject to their acceptance.

1 Section 3. Any person, persons, firm or corporation engaging
2 in the above business shall give a good and sufficient bond to
3 the City of Warrenton when required by the Committee on Streets
4 and Public Ways in such sum or amount as may be designated by the
5 said Committee on Streets and Public Ways, to indemnify the City
6 of Warrenton against all claims for damages, said bond to be
7 approved by the Mayor.

8 Section 4. Any person, persons, firm or corporation violat-
9 ing any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty
10 of misdemeanor and upon conviction therefor before the Auditor
11 and Police Judge, shall be fined not less than five dollars (\$5.00)
12 nor more than fifty dollars (\$50.00), or by imprisonment in the City
13 Jail not exceeding twenty-five (25) days.

14 Section 5. Inasmuch as the objects to be obtained by this
15 Ordinance will be of great benefit to the people of the City of
16 Warrenton, and there exists and is an urgent necessity that this
17 Ordinance should take effect as soon as possible, so that the health,
18 peace and safety of the people of the City of Warrenton may be
19 preserved, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Sec-
20 tion therefore, shall take effect when adopted by the affirmative
21 vote of two-thirds of all the members of the Common Council, and
22 this ordinance shall then be in full force and effect, immediately
23 after its approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
