

AN ORDINANCE levying taxes for general Municipal purposes for bond interest and for dyke districts Numbers One (1), Two (2) and Three (3), and ~~Sanitary and~~ <sup>Water Commission</sup> ~~collection~~ purposes for the year 1919, on the 1918 Tax Roll, adopting, confirming and approving Budget submitted and filed by the Committee on Ways and Means of the Common Council of the City of Warrenton with the Auditor and Police Judge giving an estimate of General Municipal expenses for year 1919, including bond interest for said year.

WHEREAS, the Committee on Ways and Means of the Common Council of the City of Warrenton has prepared, submitted and filed with the Auditor and Police Judge a Budget of estimated General Municipal expenses including bond interest for year 1919, which said Budget is hereby referred to and made a part hereof, and

WHEREAS, the Assessment Roll for Clatsop County, State of Oregon, for the year 1918, has been completed and equalized and the taxable property as shown in the corporate limits of the City of Warrenton, subject to taxation and listed for that purpose, is <sup>estimated at</sup>  $\$1,919.067^{00}$ , plus value of property of public service corporations in the sum of  $\$157,442^{00}$  <sup>as estimated</sup> being a total valuation of  $\$2,076,509^{00}$  <sup>estimated</sup> all of which is shown by the Certificate of F. P. Leinenweber, County Assessor for Clatsop County, State of Oregon, and is filed with the Auditor and Police Judge of the City of Warrenton, and

WHEREAS, the expense of the City of Warrenton for the year 1919, has been estimated at  $\$39,353^{00/100}$ , which includes  $\$12,000^{00}$  for bond interest purposes, and  $\$3,000^{00}$  for Dyke District No. One (1),  $\$2,000^{00}$  for Dyke District No. Two (2), and  $\$525^{00}$  for Dyke District No. Three (3), and  $\$5,280^{00}$  for <sup>Water</sup> ~~Sanitary and~~ ~~Commission~~ purposes.

~~and the expense for the year 1919, has been estimated at \$ \_\_\_\_\_, from certain fixed incomes, and said \_\_\_\_\_ is \_\_\_\_\_ raised by taxation upon all the assessable property within the corporate limits of the City of Warrenton, all of which appears from the report of the Committee on Ways and Means of the Common Council of the City of Warrenton, and the report of the Water Commission, the same being a body of the government of the City of Warrenton, Oregon, to all of which reports reference is hereby~~

made, therefor,

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is levied a tax in the sum of 39,353<sup>00</sup>, which said tax includes the sum of 16,548<sup>00</sup> for General Municipal purposes for the year 1919, for the City of Warrenton, and includes the sum of 12,000<sup>00</sup> for bond interest purposes for the City of Warrenton, and the sum of 3,000<sup>00</sup> for Dyke District No. One (1), and the sum of 2,000<sup>00</sup> for Dyke District No. Two (2), and the sum of 525<sup>00</sup> for Dyke District No. Three (3), and the sum of 5280<sup>00</sup> for ~~Sanitary and Sewerage~~ <sup>Water</sup> ~~Commission~~ purposes, all for year 1919, all of said tax being levied upon all assessable property within the City of Warrenton, as shown, listed, assessed and valued upon the Assessment Roll for Clatsop County, Oregon, for the year 1918, for the City of Warrenton.

Section 2. The Budget as prepared, submitted and ~~and~~ filed by the Committee on Ways and Means of the Common Council of the City of Warrenton, with the Auditor and Police Judge and dated November 1st 1918, be and the same is hereby referred to and made a part hereof as though set out in full herein, and is hereby adopted, approved and confirmed.

Section 3. That the Auditor and Police Judge of the City of Warrenton be and he is hereby authorized and directed to furnish to the County Clerk and also to the County Assessor of Clatsop County, Oregon, as required by law, a Certificate showing the amount of taxes levied by this Ordinance, and said certificate shall be furnished to said Officials within the time and in the manner as prescribed and provided by law.

Section 4. Inasmuch as the objects to be obtained by this ordinance will be of great benefit to the people of the City of Warrenton, and there exists and is an urgent necessity that this Ordinance should take effect as soon as possible, so that the peace and safety of the people of the City of Warrenton may be preserved, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Section therefore shall take effect when adopted by the affirmative vote of two thirds of all the members of the Common Council, and this Ordinance shall then be in full force and effect immediately after its approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
