ORDINANCE NO. <u>236 A</u> Introduced by Commissioner Jay N. Coffey

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE A FINANCIAL RESERVE FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF RETIRING AND PURCHASING OUTSTANDING BONDS OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

Section 1. - Under authority of Oregon Laws 1945, Chapter 453, the City of Warrenton hereby establishes a financial reserve for the purpose of retiring and purchasing outstanding bonds of the City of Warrenton.

An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall go into force and effect immediately upon passage and approval.
