

ORDINANCE NO. 239

An ordinance providing for the purchase of lots nine (9) and ten (10) in block three (3) Matiers edition, in the City of Warrenton, County of Clatsop, State of Oregon, to be used as a City Pound, and appropriating out of the <sup>fund, the of</sup> general sum three hundred and seventy five (\$375.00) dollars in payment for the same.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriating out of the general fund of the City of Warrenton the sum of three hundred and seventy five (\$375.00) dollars for the purchase of lots nine (9) and ten (10) in block three (3), Matiers edition, in the City of Warrenton, County of Clatsop, State of Oregon, the said property to be used as a City Pound.

Section 2. In as much as the objects to be obtained by this ordinance will be of great benefit to the people of the City of Warrenton, and there exists and is an urgent necessity that this ordinance should take effect as soon as possible, so that the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Warrenton be preserved, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this section therefore, shall take effect when adopted by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members of the Common Council, and this ordinance shall then be in full force and effect, immediately after its approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
