

AN ORDINANCE, appropriating out of the General Fund of the City of Warrenton, the sum of two hundred (\$200.00) dollars for the improvement of West Date Street between the County Road and West 8th Street, by grading the same to the established grade; and declaring an emergency.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund the sum of two hundred (\$200.00) dollars for the grading and improving of Date Street between the County Road and West 8th Street, in the City of Warrenton, to the established grade.

The Auditor and Police Judge of the City of Warrenton is hereby authorized and directed to execute a warrant in the sum of two hundred (\$200.00) dollars in favor of Montague Reilly & Co for the making of said improvement. *when work is completed and accepted by the Council*

Section 2. Inasmuch as the objects to be obtained by this ordinance will be of great benefit to the people of the City of Warrenton, and there exists and is an urgent necessity that this ordinance should take effect as soon as possible, so that the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Warrenton may be preserved, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this section therefore, shall take effect when adopted by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members of the Common Council, and this ordinance shall then be in full force and effect immediately after its approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
