

AN ORDINANCE appropriating the sum of five hundred dollars, (\$500.00) out of the General Fund of the City of Warrenton, for the payment of the purchase price of a tract of land described as follows to wit:- Beginning at a point thirty three feet Southerly from the North east corner of Lot (1) one, Block (9) nine Warrenton Addition to Astoria as platted by D.K. Warren and duly recorded in the plat records of Clatsop County, in the Westerly line of Main Street; thence Westerly on a line at right angles to the Westerly line of Main Street thirty three feet more or less to an intersection with the South easterly line of the S.P.&.S. right of way; thence along the said line of the S.P.&.S. right of way south westerly to its intersection with the Southerly line of Third Street produced. Thence easterly along the Southerly line of Third Street produced to its intersection with the Westerly line of Main Street; Thence Northerly along the Westerly line of Main Street to the point of beginning.

General public to purchase for the City of Warrenton, a tract of land for street and public purposes, from Jake Bosshart.

Section 2. That there be and is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the City of Warrenton, the sum of five hundred dollars, (\$500.00) to pay for the following tract of land,

de scribed as follows to wit:- Beginning at a point thirty three feet Southerly from the North east corner of Lot (1) one, Block (9) nine Warrenton Addition to Astoria as platted by D.K. Warren and duly recorded in the plat records of Clatsop County, in the Westerly line of Main Street; thence Westerly on a line at right angles to the Westerly line of Main Street thirty three feet more or less to an intersection with the South easterly line of the S.P.&.S. right of way; thence along the said line of the S.P.&.S. right of way south westerly to its intersection with the Southerly line of Third Street produced. Thence easterly along the Southerly line of Third Street produced to its intersection with the Westerly line of Main Street; Thence Northerly along the Westerly line of Main Street to the point of beginning.

Section 3. Inasmuch as the objects to be obtained by this ordinance will be of great benefit to the people of the City of Warrenton and there exists and is an urgent necessity that this ordinance should take effect as soon as possible, so that the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Warrenton may be preserved, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this section, therefore, shall take effect when approved by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members of the Common Council, and this ordinance shall then be in full force and operative immediately after its approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
