

ORDINANCE NO. 256a

Introduced by Commissioner Noel Rawls

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE INSTALLATION CHARGE FOR WATER TAPS AND REPEALING ALL PRIOR ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. CONNECTIONS WITH WATER MAIN. When a permit for the introduction of water has been obtained, there shall be installed a water tap and a service pipe not to exceed 60 feet in length shall be laid from the main to the parking strip or curb. Such service pipe shall be of such size as may be determined by the superintendent of the city water works, but in no event will service or other pipes smaller than $\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch in diameter be allowed. Such water tap and service pipe shall be furnished and installed at a charge of \$20.00 to cross a 60 foot street; \$25.00 to cross a street wider than 60 feet; and \$15.00 to connect with the property owner adjacent to the pipe line. Tap and service pipes shall be installed by the superintendent of the city water works. That in the event a pipe larger than the standard $\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch in diameter pipe be required that a meter shall be installed at the users expense. That in case the users wish to discontinue the water service that the City will repurchase the water meter less any depreciation.

Section 2. All ordinance, ordinances or parts of an ordinance or ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. An Emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall immediately go into force and effect upon its adoption and approval.
