AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE MOTOR VEHICLE AND OTHER TRAFFIC BY ESTABLISHING A CERTAIN STOP SIGN AT THE INTERSECTION OF DATE STREET AND SCHOOL ROAD IN THE CITY OF WARRENTON; PROHIBIT CROSSING WITHOUT STOPPING AT SAID STOP SIGN AND TO PROVIDE FOR OFFICIAL TRAFFIC STOP SIGN AND TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREBY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Date Street and School Road is a dangerous traffic intersection, and,

WHEREAS, there are no City or State stop signs located at said intersection, and,

WHEREAS, it is for the public health and safety of the residents of the City of Warrenton that a stop sign be erected at the intersection of Date Street and School Road,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That a stop sign be placed on the Westerly side of Date Street at its intersection with School Road in the City of Warrenton, Oregon, and that motor vehicles and other vehicles are prohibited from crossing said intersection without making a complete stop before proceeding over said intersection.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 207A be and is hereby affirmed and this Ordinance be and is hereby made an additional Ordinance regulating vehicular traffic.

SECTION 3. That the placing of official traffic sign consisting of a stop sign at the intersection above described be and is hereby authorized.

SECTION 4. Every person convicted of violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$150.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail of not more than 50 days. For a second or subsequent conviction within one year thereafter, such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$300.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail of not more than 150 days on by hoth such fine and imprisonment 150 days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 5. That inasmuch as this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Warrenton, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage by the City Commissioners of the City of Warrenton and approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
