THAT WHERE AS, on the Ath day of September, 1919, the Common Council of the City of Werrenton pessed an Ordinance calling for a special election to be held in the City of Werrenton on the 24th day of October, 1919, to submitt proposed Initiative measures to be voted upon by the electors of the City of Werrenton, and

WHEREAS, the Common Cou cil of the City of Werrenton hes deemed it advisable to repeal said ordinance and all acts done under said ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ordinance Number 25 of the City of Warrenton, passed by the Common Council of said City on the 36h day of September, 1919, celling for a special election to be held in the City of Warrenton, on the 24th day of October, 1919, be and the same is hereby repealed, and all sots done and performed under said ordinance are hereby rescinded and held for nought.

Section 2. Insemuch as the objects to be obtained by this ordinance will be of prest benefit to the people of the City of Astoria, and there exists and is an urgent necessity that this ordinance should take effect as seen as possible, so that the health, peace and safety of the City of Warrenton may be preserved, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this section therefore shall take effect when approved by the effirmstive vote of 2/3 of all the members of the Cormon Council, and this ordinance shall then be in full force and operative immediately after its pressage and approvel by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
