

ORDINANCE NO. 266 a

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ALL PRIOR ORDINANCES REGULATING FIRE WORKS AND FIRE CRACKERS AND PROHIBITING THE SALE, POSSESSION OR DISCHARGE OF FIRE WORKS OR FIRE CRACKERS WITHIN THE CITY OF WARRENTON, PROVIDING PENALTIES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That all prior Ordinances regulating fire works and fire crackers be and are hereby repealed.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, minor, firm or corporation to possess, sell or offer to sell, give away or dispose of in any manner fire works or fire crackers within the City limits of the City of Warrenton, except for a period of seven days before the 4th of July of any year and the 4th, 5th and 6th of July of any year.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any person or minor to fire, explode or discharge in any manner fire works or fire crackers within the City limits of the City of Warrenton, except on the first seven days before the 4th of July in any year and except on the 4th, 5th and 6th of July of any year.

Section 4. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof before the Auditor and Police Judge, be punished by a fine of not to exceed \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail for a period of not to exceed 30 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 5. That inasmuch as this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Warrenton an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Commission and approval by the Mayor.
