ORDINANCE NO. 268.

AN ORDINANCE fixing the selary of the Auditor and Police Judge, City Marshal, City Attorney and City Engineer of the City of Warrenton, for the year 1920, and declaring an emergency.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the salary of the Auditor and Police Judge, John Evenden, be and the same is hereby fixed at $\frac{1}{20000}$ per month for the year 1920.

Section 2. That the salary of the City Marshal, §. B. Spangenbarg, be and the same is hereby fixed at § 90^{-2} , per month, for the year 1920.

Section 3. That the salary of the City Attorney, O. B. Setters, be and the same is hereby fixed at $\frac{500}{500}$, per month, for the year 1920, which shall include all municipal court cases of the City of Warrenton in the municipal court, and on appeal to the Circuit Court of the County of Clatsop, State of Oregon.

Section 4. That the salary of the City Engineer, J. O. Baar, be and the same is hereby fixed at $\frac{500}{500}$ per month, for the year 1920, and all services rendered by the said City Engineer, J. C. Baar, over and above <u>Gight</u> full days per month, shall be paid for at the rate of $\frac{500}{500}$ per day.

Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 6. Insemuch as the objects to be obtained by this ordinance will be of great benefit to the people of the City of Warrenton, and there exists and is an urgent necessity that this ordinance should take effect as soon as possible, so that the health, peace and safety of the City of Warrenton may be preserved, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this section therefore shall take effect when approved by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members of the Common Council, and this ordinance shall then be in full force and
