

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND FIXING THE FEES TO BE CHARGED BY THE WATER COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON, ON APPLICATION FOR PERMISSION TO INSTALL AND MAKE CONNECTION WITH THE WATER MAINS OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That upon all applications for permit to make connections with the Water mains by individuals, corporations, or otherwise, that there be and is hereby fixed a standing charge of Ten (\$10.00) dollars for each permit granted to make connection with the water mains of the City of Warrenton.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Inasmuch as the objects to be obtained by this ordinance will be of great benefit to the people of the City of Warrenton, and there exists and is an urgent necessity that this ordinance should take effect as soon as possible, so that the health, peace and safety of the City of Warrenton may be preserved, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this section therefore shall take effect when approved by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members of the Common Council, and this ordinance shall then be in full force and operative immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
