

ORDINANCE NO. 280-A

Introduced by Commissioner Quincy Robinson

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING BEER TAVERNS TO STAY OPEN UNTIL ONE O'CLOCK A.M. IN THE MORNING AND NOT THEREAFTER IN THE CITY OF WARRENTON AND REPEALING ALL PRIOR ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That all beer taverns in the City of Warrenton be and they are hereby allowed to stay open until one o'clock A.M. in the morning.

Section 2. The aforesaid beer taverns are hereby prohibited from staying open later than one o'clock A.M. in the morning in the City of Warrenton.

Section 3. That all prior ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
