AN ORDINANCE standardizing the construction of sidewalks in the City of Warrenton, Clatsop County, Oregonk and declaring an emergency.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

ORDINANCE NO. 291

Section 1. That all sidewalks constructed in the City of Warrenton shall be constructed of either wood or coment, and shall conform to the following specifications, to-wit:

When constructed of wood the sidewalk shall be due feet wide, built with 100-8"x 6 SIS planks laid upon 1/100-3"x 6 size to be specified mud sills, the said surface planks to be stringers, on _ fastened to the said stringers by 20 penny nails; and

When constructed of concrete or cement it shall be laid upon a base of rock and cement For inches thick, and the surface shall be Mulfulf inches thick laid upon top of the base, and shall be feet wide, and built so as to conform to the established grade.

Section 2. Insmuch as the objects to be obtained by this ordinance will be of great benefit to the people of the City of Warrenton and there exists and is an urgent necessity that this ordinance should take effect as soon as possible, so that the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Warrenton may be preserved, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this section, therefore, shall take effect when approved by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members of the Common Council, and this ordinance shall then be in full force and operative immediately after its approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
