

ORDINANCE NO. 296. 1st one (there is two
296's)

AN ORDINANCE, FIXING THE DATES AND HOURS OF THE MEETINGS OF THE COMMON COUNCIL, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That on and after the date of the enactment of this ordinance, the dates and hours of the meetings of the Common Council of the City of Warrenton shall be as follows, to-wit: The first, and the fifteenth, days, respectively, of each month, at the hour of 7:30 P. M.; provided, that whenever the first and the fifteenth days of the month, or either of them, shall fall on a Sunday, legal holiday, or other non-judicial day, then, said Common Council shall meet at the hour of 7:30 P. M. on the next succeeding judicial day.

Section 2. That the enactment of this ordinance at this time, and the taking effect of the same forthwith, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Warrenton, and, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.

Section 3. That all ordinances, and parts of ordinances, in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
