

ORDINANCE NO. 2977

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE A FINANCIAL RESERVE FUND FOR STATE TAX STREET FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPAIRING, MAINTAINING, CONSTRUCTING AND RECONSTRUCTING THE CITY STREETS OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON AND FOR ANY OTHER PURPOSES AUTHORIZED BY LAW FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF STATE TAX STREET FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

Section 1 - Under authority of Oregon Laws, 1945, Chapter 453, the City of Warrenton hereby establishes a financial reserve fund for State Tax Street Funds for the purpose of repairing, maintaining, constructing and reconstructing the city streets of the City of Warrenton and for any other purposes authorized by law for the expenditure of State Tax Street Funds.

An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall go into force and effect immediately upon passage and approval.
