

ORDINANCE NO. 2997

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR GENERAL MUNICIPAL PURPOSES FOR THE CITY OF WARRENTON FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING AS OF JULY 1, 1951 AND ENDING AS OF JULY 1, 1952, UPON SAID FISCAL TAX ROLL, CONFIRMING, APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE BUDGET AS PREPARED, SUBMITTED AND ACTED UPON BY THE LEVYING BOARD AND THE BUDGET COMMITTEE OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby levied a tax for general municipal purposes for the City of Warrenton for the fiscal year of July 1, 1951 to July 1, 1952, upon said fiscal tax roll the sum of \$ 15,968.07 and that said tax as aforesaid is hereby

declared levied upon all of the taxable property within the City limits of the City of Warrenton, Clatsop County, State of Oregon.

Section 2. That there be and is hereby levied a tax for general dyking purposes for the City of Warrenton, Oregon, for the fiscal year of July 1, 1951 to July 1, 1952, upon said fiscal year tax roll the following sums in the following districts, to-wit:

Dyking District #1 the sum of \$ 1200.00; Dyking District #2 the sum of \$ 1200.00; Dyking District #3 the sum of \$ 500.00;

and that said tax as aforesaid is hereby duly levied upon all of the taxable property lying within the limits of the respective dyking districts situated in the City of Warrenton, Clatsop County, State of Oregon.

Section 3. That the budget for general municipal expenses and purposes, dyking districts, for the City of Warrenton for the fiscal year of July 1, 1951 to July 1, 1952, upon said fiscal year tax roll, as prepared, submitted and adopted by the Levying board and Budget Committee of the City of Warrenton be and the said budget is hereby approved, confirmed and adopted, and is hereby referred to and made a part of this tax levying Ordinance as though set out in full herein.

Section 4. That the Auditor and Police Judge of the City of Warrenton be and he is hereby directed to notify, in writing, the County Assessor and the County Clerk of Clatsop County, State of Oregon, of the amount of money proposed to be raised by taxation not later than the 15th day of July, 1951.

Page One, Ordinance.

An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall go into force and effect immediately upon passage and approval.
