

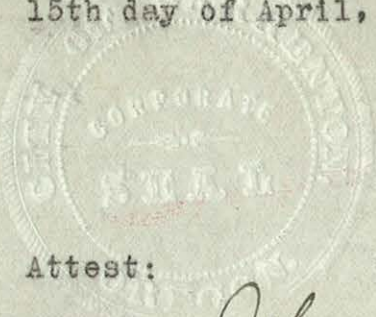
AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 267 OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That ordinance No. 267 of the City of Warrenton, passed by the Common Council, and approved by the Mayor, on the 5th day of January, 1920, be, and the same hereby is, repealed.

Section 2. That the enactment of this ordinance at this time, and the taking effect of the same forthwith, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Warrenton, and, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on the 15th day of April, A. D. 1921.
