

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE POLLUTION OF THE WATER SUPPLY OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON, AND PROVIDING PUNISHMENT FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That in pursuance of the authority delegated to the Common Council by the statutes and constitution of the State of Oregon, and particularly by Chapter 183 of the General Laws of Oregon of 1919, all persons are hereby prohibited from doing any act, or anything, that will result in the contamination or pollution of the water supply of the City of Warrenton, including the water shed near and adjacent to its reservoirs, and its reservoirs, water mains, pipes, and laterals, and particularly that part of said water shed, owned by said City, described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the center line of main pipe line conveying water from Lewis & Clark River to said City of Warrenton, at station 280x60, where the same intersects the North line of said E. B. Andrew tract in the Southwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) Section Twelve (12) Township Six (6) North Range Ten (10) West Will. Mer., which line is the North line of said Southwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$); thence west along said quarter section line to a point 100 ft. distant measured at right angles to said center line of pipe line; thence South 11 degrees, 18 minutes East, 700 ft. parallel to and 100 ft. distant from said center of pipe line; thence East to the center line of said pipe line at Station 287x60; thence continuing along said line to a point 100 ft. from said pipe line measured at right angles thereto; thence North 11 degrees 18 minutes West 800 ft. parallel to and 100 ft. distant from said center line of said pipe line; thence west to the place of beginning, containing 3.21 acres to the same, more or less, all of which is situated in the North one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twelve (12) Township 6 (6) North Range Ten (10) West Willamette Mer. --and-- The Northwest quarter of Section Twenty-one (21) Township six (6) North of Range Nine (9) West of Willamette Meridian; all the above being situated in Clatsop County State of Oregon. Also the South half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of Section 19 Township 6, North of Range 9, West, Willamette Meridian.

Section 2. That the Rules and Regulations of the State Board of Health of Oregon, which are now in force, or may hereafter be adopted, are hereby referred to and made a part of this ordinance, so far as they may be applicable to the Warrenton Water Supply, watershed and water system, and any violation thereof shall be a violation of this ordinance.

Section 3. That any person found guilty, in the Municipal Court of the City of Warrenton, before the Auditor and Police Judge, of violating any provision of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$300.00, or by imprisonment in the City Jail of

Warrenton for a period not exceeding six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the officer presiding over said Court.
