

ORDINANCE NO. 311A

Introduced by Commissioner Noel Parks

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE MOTOR VEHICLE AND OTHER TRAFFIC BY ESTABLISHING PARALLEL PARKING ON ALL STREETS, HIGHWAYS AND PUBLIC ALLEYS IN THE CITY OF WARRENTON, PROHIBITING ANY PARKING OTHER THAN PARALLEL PARKING ON SAID STREETS, HIGHWAYS AND PUBLIC ALLEYS AND TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, AND PROVIDING FOR OFFICIAL TRAFFIC SIGNS.

WHEREAS, it is dangerous for people to park in any manner other than parallel on the streets, highways and public alleys in the City of Warrenton, County of Clatsop, State of Oregon, and

WHEREAS, it is for the public health and safety of the residents of the City of Warrenton that any parking but parallel parking be prohibited on the streets, highways and public alleys in the City of Warrenton;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. That parallel parking is hereby established in the City of Warrenton on its streets, highways and public alleys and any parking but parallel parking is prohibited on the streets, highways and public alleys of the City of Warrenton, County of Clatsop, State of Oregon, and placing of official traffic signs of "Parallel Parking Only" on any public thoroughfares be and is hereby affirmed.
2. That Ordinance No. 207-A be and is hereby affirmed and this Ordinance be and is hereby made an additional Ordinance regulating vehicular traffic.

3. That every person convicted of violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$150.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail of not more than 60 days. For a second or subsequent conviction within one year thereafter, each person shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$300.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail of not more than 150 days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

4. That inasmuch as this Ordinance is necessary for the protection of the residents of the City of Warrenton in regard to traffic hazards, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage by the City Commissioners of the City of Warrenton and approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
