ORDINANCES

"Ordinance No. 317.2, an ordinance authorizing the Mayor and the Auditor and Police Judge in the name of the City of Warrenton to enter into a street lighting contract with Pacific Power & Light Company for increased and corrected street lighting, was introduced by Commissioner Quincy KoBINSON, Ordinance No. 317 19 containing no emergency clause was read in full three times as required by charter after which it was placed on passage by roll call vote, the vote being as follows: _eye, ___ ____aye, eye, aye, and aye. The vote being all ayes and all commissioners present the Mayor declared the ordinance passed and immediately affixed his signature. A copy of Ordinance No. _____becoming effective twenty days after passage, is made a part of these minutes of record."

This is to certify that the above statement is a true copy of City Commission proceedings relating to enactment of Ordinance No.______. The Ordinance was passed by the City Commission of the City of Warrenton at their regular meeting held _______, and contained within the minutes of that meeting.

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing the execution and delivery in the name and on behalf of the City of Warrenton, Oregon, of a contract with Pacific Power & Light Company, a corporation, providing for the furnishing by said Pacific Power & Light Company to said City of electric lighting service upon the streets, highways and public places within the corporate limits of said City for a period of five (5) years from and after the effective date of this Ordinance, a copy of the contract so authorized being set forth in this Ordinance, and declaring such service essential to the security and welfare of said City and its inhabitants.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City of Warrenton make and enter into a contract with Pacific Power & Light Company, a corporation, providing for the furnishing by said Pacific Power & Light Company to the City of Warrenton of electric lighting service for lighting the streets, highways and public places within the corporate limits of the City of Warrenton, for the period of five (5) years from and after the effective date of this Ordinance, which contract shall be signed by the Mayor, sealed with the corporate seal of the City and attested by the Auditor and Police Judge of the City of Warrenton, and shall be in words and figures as follows: Section 3. The Company, upon receipt of written orders from the City, and subject to the availability of manpower and required materials and equipment, will install upon its overhead circuits within the corporate limits of said city, at the new locations thereon specified in such orders, such incandescent filament type lamps of any of the standard lumen ratings mentioned in Section 6 hereof as the City may from time to time direct.

Section 4. The Company, at any time upon receipt of written order from the City, will discontinue the operation of any light or lamp then in service to the Company's said overhead street lighting system hereunder as specified in such order; and no further payment shall be required of the City in respect of the operation of any such light or lamp after the Company's receipt of such order of discontinuance.

Section 5. Each order for a change in the lighting service to be furnished by the Company hereunder, as provided in the foregoing Sections 3 and 4 hereof, shall be executed in duplicate by the Mayor or the Auditor and Police Judge of the City, substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit B and made a part hereof. The Company, upon receipt of any such order, shall endorse thereon the date of its receipt over the signature of the Company's authorized representative, and shall return one counterpart of such order so endorsed to the City. When and as any change specified in such order shall have been completed, the Company shall report the fact and the date of such completion in writing to the City, identifying the work with the particular order of the City directing such change. Section 6. For the street lighting service to be furnished by the Company as hereinbefore provided, the City will pay to the Company in accordance with the following schedule of rates, to be applied to the lamps from time to time in service hereunder, namely:

It is understood that the Company's rates and charges for street lighting services are and at all times shall be subject to the lawful orders or regulations of the Public Utilities Commissioner of the State of Oregon, or any other governmental authority having jurisdiction thereof, and that the Company's rates for street lighting service hereunder are subject to change from time to time by lawful order of said regulatory authority.

Section 7. Should the Company at any time become unable to obtain new incandescent filament type lamps for replacements hereunder, because of the manufacturers' discontinuing the making of lamps of the same types and lumen ratings, or for any other good cause, the Company will install and thereafter operate at the locations of the lamps so superseded a like number of incandescent lamps of approximately similar standard lumen rating then commercially available, and thereafter the City will pay for the operation and maintenance of such substitute lamps the Company's regularly published and filed tariff rates applicable thereto.

Section 8. The Company will at all times hereunder, except when prevented by accident or other cause beyond its reasonable control, supply the necessary electric energy, and the necessary service for switching on and off such energy, for continuous dusk to daylight operation of all lights or lamps provided for hereunder, and will promptly replace all such lights or lamps which shall have burned out or ceased to be useful. The City shall not be required to pay for the operation of any light or lamp in respect of any night during which such light or lamp shall have been out of service for any cause for the full nightly period, and a ratable reduction shall be made in the monthly bill hereunder for any such light or lamp for each such outage. The Company, however, shall not be chargeable for or on account of any outage or failure of service hereunder beyond or other than such ratable reduction in the monthly bill.

Section 9. Payment for service furnished each month under this contract shall be made by the City to the Company at the Company's office in Astoria, Oregon, within ten (10) days after receipt of the Company's bill for the service furnished during such month.

Section 10. This contract and all of the terms and provisions hereof shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the successors and assigns of the parties hereto, respectively.

(End of Form of Contract except testimonium clause, signatures and seals.)

Section 2. It is hereby determined by the Commission of the City of Warrenton that the lighting service provided for in the contract hereby authorized is necessary to enable said City to provide proper protection for itself and the inhabitants thereof, and is essential to the security and welfare of said City and its inhabitants.

Section 3. The Mayor of the city of Warrenton is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver such contract with Pacific Power & Light Company in the name and on behalf of the city of Warrenton, and the Auditor and Police Judge of the city of Warrenton is hereby authorized and directed to affix the seal of said City to said contract and to attest the same, upon execution thereof by the Mayor, as herein provided.
