

ORDINANCE NO. 318A

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE MOTOR VEHICLE AND OTHER TRAFFIC BY ESTABLISHING A STOP SIGN ON THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF MARKET AND MAIN STREETS IN THE CITY OF WARRENTON; PROHIBIT CROSSING WITHOUT STOPPING AT SAID POINT AND TO PROVIDE FOR OFFICIAL TRAFFIC SIGNS AND TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

WHEREAS, Where Market and Main Streets intersect there is a dangerous intersection with regard to vehicular traffic, and

WHEREAS, There are no city or state stop signs located at said intersection, and

WHEREAS, It is for the public health and safety of the residents of the City of Warrenton that a stop sign or signs be erected on the Northeast corner of Market and Main Streets,

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a stop sign or stop signs be placed on the Northeast corner of Market and Main Streets in Warrenton, Oregon and that motor vehicles and other vehicles are prohibited from crossing said intersection without making a complete stop before crossing over said intersection.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 207A be and is hereby affirmed and this Ordinance be and is hereby made an additional Ordinance regulating vehicular traffic.

Section 3. That the placing of official traffic signs consisting of stop signs at said intersection above described be and is hereby authorized.

Section 4. That every person convicted of violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$150.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail of not more than 50 days. For a second or subsequent conviction within one year thereafter, such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$300.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail of not more than 150 days or by both such fine and imprisonment.
