AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND AUDITOR AND POLICE JUDGE OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A MODIFICATION OF WATER AGREEMENT WITH HAMMOND, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, DATED DECEMBER 4, 1952, DELETING PARAGRAPH 13 IN SAID AGREEMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:

ORDINANCE NO. 320A

WHEREAS, the City of Warrenton has been supplying surplus water to the water users of Hammond under a Water Agreement dated December 4, 1952, and

WHEREAS, the City of Warrenton deems Paragraph 13 of said Water Agreement unnecessary and burdensome to the City of Warrenton because of high insurance rates,

NOW THEREFORE, the CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor and Police Judge of the City of Warrenton be and they are hereby ordered and directed to execute a written Modification of its Water Agreement with Hammond, a municipal corporation, dated December 4, 1952, said written Modification to delete Paragraph 13 of the original Water Agreement dated December 4, 1952.

Section 2. That inasmuch as this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, peace and safety of the City of Warrenton in order to reduce large insurance premiums which are needed for the running of the water system of the City of Warrenton, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be deemed in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Commission and approval by the Mayor.
