

ORDINANCE NO. 3287

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 302-A BY REPEALING SECTION 2 AND ADDING A NEW SECTION 2 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 302-A be and is hereby repealed.

Section 2. That provisions of Oregon Revised Statutes and any amendments or additions thereto relating to the acquisition, possession or disposition of alcoholic liquors, and all duly promulgated rules and regulations of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission are hereby adopted as a provision of this ordinance so far as applicable except as otherwise lawfully provided by this and other ordinances.

Section 3. Inasmuch as it is necessary to provide a means whereby the Municipal Court shall have jurisdiction over violations of liquor laws, and

WHEREAS, the City has been formerly using state liquor control laws set out in Oregon Compiled Laws Annotated, and

WHEREAS, Oregon Revised Statutes are now in effect and Oregon Compiled Laws Annotated are not, it is deemed necessary that an emergency be declared to exist and this ordinance shall become immediately operative from and after its passage by the City Commissioners.
