

ORDINANCE NO. 3297

Introduced by Commissioner Quincy Robinson

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THOSE PARTS OF THE PLATS KNOWN AS LOTS 4,  
5, 6, 7, BLOCK 10, WARRENTON PARK; LOTS 11, 12, 13, 14, BLOCK 11,  
WARRENTON PARK; LOTS 1, 2, 3, 4, BLOCK 17, WARRENTON PARK; LOTS 19,  
20, BLOCK 20, FIRST EXTENSION OF EAST WARRENTON; LOTS 1, 2, 3, 4, 5,  
6, BLOCK 21, FIRST EXTENSION OF EAST WARRENTON; LOTS 9 TO 15  
INCLUSIVE, BLOCK 27, FIRST EXTENSION OF EAST WARRENTON, ALL IN THE  
CITY OF WARRENTON, COUNTY OF CLATSOP, STATE OF OREGON.

WHEREAS, JOHN C. WILLEMER and EVA WILLEMER, husband and wife,  
and E. EDWARD WILLEMER and BEATRICE WILLEMER, husband and wife,  
and HENRY C. WILLEMER and DOROTHY WILLEMER, husband and wife, and  
HENRY C. WILLEMER, Administrator of the estate of LOUISE B.  
WILLEMER, deceased filed a Petition with the City Auditor and  
Police Judge asking for the vacation of those parts of the plats  
known as Lots 4, 5, 6, 7, Block 10, Warrenton Park; Lots 11, 12,  
13, 14, Block 11, Warrenton Park; Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, Block 17,  
Warrenton Park; Lots 19, 20, Block 20, First Extension of East  
Warrenton; Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, Block 21, First Extension of  
East Warrenton; Lots 9 to 15 inclusive, Block 27, First Extension  
of East Warrenton, all in the City of Warrenton, County of Clatsop,  
State of Oregon, and  
WHEREAS, the Petitioners are interested in the above described  
real property and said Petition has been presented to the City  
Auditor and Police Judge who has examined said Petition and found  
it sufficient; and

WHEREAS, said Petition was presented to the City Commission  
of the City of Warrenton on March 15, 1954, who found no reason  
manifestly existing why said Petition should not be allowed in  
whole or in part and by Resolution fixed the time for a formal  
hearing upon said Petition as April 19, 1954, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock  
P.M. of said day, at the City Hall of the City of Warrenton, at  
Warrenton, Oregon, and  
WHEREAS, due notice of the time and place of this hearing was  
given as by law required, and as set out in the affidavit of the  
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City Auditor and Police Judge, E. R. Baldwin, which was filed by him, and

WHEREAS, said formal hearing was held at the appointed time and place and the Petition and objections thereto were heard by the City Commission who ascertained and determined that the consent of the owners of the requisite area has been obtained and that notice had been duly given and that the public interest of the City of Warrenton would not be prejudiced by the vacation of those parts of the plats described herein and which the petitioners ask to be vacated and these matters having been determined in favor of the petitioners by the City Commission;

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That those parts of the plats known as

Lots 4, 5, 6, 7, Block 10, Warrenton Park; Lots 11, 12, 13, 14, Block 11, Warrenton Park; Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, Block 17, Warrenton Park; Lots 19, 20, Block 29, First Extension of East Warrenton; Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, Block 21, First Extension of East Warrenton; Lots 9 to 15 inclusive, Block 27, First Extension of East Warrenton, all in the City of Warrenton, County of Clatsop, State of Oregon, be and the same are hereby vacated, and that said vacation of said parts of the plats is hereby made a matter of record, but it is hereby

expressly provided that the petitioners shall forthwith pay into the City Treasury the cost of obtaining the necessary changes on the public records so as to indicate as required by law such vacation, and it is hereby provided that the City Auditor and Police Judge shall file with the County Clerk of Clatsop County, State of Oregon, a certified copy of this Ordinance and file with the County Assessor and the County Surveyor a certified copy of this ordinance. Nothing contained herein shall cause or require the removal or abandonment of any sewer, water main, conduit of any kind, wires, poles, or any other thing used or intended to be used for any public service, and the right is hereby reserved to maintain, continue, repair, reconstruct, renew, replace, rebuild and/or enlarge any and all such things.
