AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, CITY COMMISSIONERS AND AUDITOR AND POLICE JUDGE TO MAKE, EXECUTE AND DELIVER A DEED TO THE PUBLIC OF A SIXTY FOOT STREET IN SMITHS WARRENTON IN THE CITY OF WARRENTON, COUNTY OF CLATSOP, STATE OF OREGON TO BE KNOWN AS DATE STREET EXTENSION.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor, City Commissioners and Auditor and Police Judge be and they are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver a Deed to The Public of a Sixty foot strip of land for street purposes to be known as Date Street on each side Extension being thirty feet in width/ of the following described center line:

"Beginning at Engineers centerline Station 8 + 13.1 P.C., said Station being in the center line of Larch Street 76.90 feet northerly of the northerly line of Sixth Street; thence on a 572.96 foot radius curve to the left (the long chord of which bears S6° 43' 30" W, 338.1 feet) a distance of 343.2 feet; thence S10° 26' E a distance of 552.7 feet; thence on a 572.96 foot radius curve right (the long chord of which bears S 5° 24' 30" E, 100.4 feet) a distance of 100.5 feet to a point on the South line of Block 31, in Smiths Warrenton, said point also being in the centerline of Date Street (West Warrenton) if extended northerly, Smiths Warrenton, City of Warrenton, County of Clatsop, State of Oregon".
