

ORDINANCE NO. 336 A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 308A BY ADDING A NEW CLAUSE CHARGING EACH WATER ACCOUNT OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON WITHIN AND WITHOUT THE CITY AN ADDITIONAL TWENTY-FIVE CENTS PER MONTH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 18 of Ordinance 308A be and is hereby amended by adding to said section an additional clause which clause reads as follows:

Every water account within and without the City of Warrenton shall be and hereby is charged an additional sum of twenty-five cents per month. This shall be an additional rate to any other rate charged by Ordinance No. 308A or any amendment thereto other than this amendment.

Section 2. That inasmuch as the use of water is an emergency and inasmuch as additional equipment and supplies need to be added to and furnished to the water system of the City of Warrenton forthwith and in the immediate future, an emergency is hereby declared to exist as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Warrenton and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage by the City Commissioners of the City of Warrenton and approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
