

ORDINANCE NO. 341A

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, CITY COMMISSIONERS AND AUDITOR AND POLICE JUDGE TO MAKE, EXECUTE AND DELIVER A DEED TO THE REAL PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN THIS ORDINANCE TO THE STATE OF OREGON BY AND THROUGH ITS STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION FOR STATE PARK PURPOSES WITH THE RIGHT OF REVERSION.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor, City Commissioners and the Auditor and Police Judge be and they are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver a Deed to the State of Oregon, by and through its State Highway Commission, to the following described real property not needed for municipal public use:

"All that portion of Lot 3, Section 18, Township 8 North, Range 10 West, Willamette Meridian, which lies East of the easterly line of Burma Road, also

Beginning at a point, which point is 1350.0 feet West of the section corner common to Sections 7, 8, 18 and 17, Township 8 North, Range 10 West, Willamette Meridian;

thence South a distance of 1100.0 feet to a point;

thence West a distance of 100.0 feet to a point on the East right of way line of a road known as the Russel-Iredale Road;


thence in a Northwesterly direction along the East right of way of said road to a point 2250.0 feet West of the section corner common to Sections 7, 8, 18 and 17, Township 8 North, Range 10 West, Willamette Meridian;

thence East 900.0 feet to the point of beginning being all in Section 18, Township 8 North, Range 10 West, Willamette Meridian, containing 12.00 acres more or less,"

for state park purposes with right of reversion in case real property is not used for a consecutive period of five years for state park purposes.
