

ORDINANCE NO. 353A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 21 of ORDINANCE NO. 342A IN REGARD TO RATES AND CHARGES

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 21 of Ordinance No. 342A is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 21a. Service pipes and meters of suitable sizes will be furnished upon application to the Water Department and the prepayment therefor, as hereafter provided, and the Water Department shall furnish all labor and materials necessary for such construction, including tapping of mains, installation of corporation cocks, meter, meter box and connections and such quality and type of pipe as may be necessary. The rates to be charged for furnishing meters and for laying and constructing such service pipe by the Water Department shall be as follows:

Minimum \$75.00 for 5/8" by 3/4" and proportionately more as labor and materials increase in cost. Larger meters at market price.

When \$75.00 has been paid for the meter and service pipe, the meter belongs to the property owner, but the city will repurchase the meter based on market value at the time of repurchase if the property owner wishes to sell, as in the case of the sale of the premises or a non-use for water. If existing service is to be metered, there will be a minimum charge of \$40.00 for the installation of the meter and an increased cost if the cost of labor and materials increases.

SECTION 21b. If no meter is installed or required, the minimum charge for laying and constructing such service pipe by the Water Department and tap shall be \$40.00 and an increased cost if the cost of labor and materials increases.
