

ORDINANCE NO. 37117

AN ORDINANCE RAISING THE SALARY AND COMPENSATION OF ALL THE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON, EXCEPT THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSIONERS, THREE PER CENT. MORE THAN THEIR PRESENT COMPENSATION


WHEREAS, the cost of living has increased during the past year,

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the salary and compensation of all the officers and employees of the City of Warrenton, except the Mayor and the City Commissioners, be and is hereby raised Three per cent. more than the present compensation of said city employees or officers as set either by Ordinance or otherwise. *effective Jan. 1, 1958*
